



I Will Show You a Door

The Lord says, "I will show you a door, the **Door of Promise**. The only way you will see through this door is to look **beyond the door before you**. It will be like **looking and turning in to the God of Promise, the One who made the promise**. The persons who will enter this door must **search more for the God of Promise** than the God that just *made* the promises."

"You must **believe like Abraham**, who was completely convinced and persuaded without wavering, that **whatever promise God has made to you, He will fulfill it**. Not because you deserve it or don't deserve it; you didn't perform right or you did."
(Rom. 4:20)

"No!" God says, "That doesn't have anything to do with it! **It is My Word and I AM THE PROMISE!** And in ME is 'YES' and 'AMEN' and I AM THE GOD OF ALL PROMISE."
(2 Cor. 1:20)

"**Every promise that ever flowed from My lips, I will fulfill it**", says the Lord, "for I am the One that breathes a promise and My Word will not ever return to Me void. The promises I made to you and your generations and your family line, I **am able to perform it and fulfill it at My exact time**," says the Father. (Isa. 55:11, Gal. 6:9)

"So I will bring in My people in this season, for those that are seeking, who are hungry and are thirsting, I will bring them in to the **Gate of Righteousness and the Door of Promise**." (Mat. 5:6, Ps. 118:19)

"There are **many doors through the Gate of Righteousness**; many doors you have not seen before; many doors you have not explored before; many doors that are untold mysteries unfolded in this time," says the Lord.

“Continue to follow Me in through this gate and these doors that I open before you,” the Lord said. “Did I not say to John, ‘for behold a door was opened in heaven’; not a gate, but a door?” (Rev. 4:1)

And God said, “I am going to begin to open up multiple doors for you to **see into places like you have never seen before**. I am going to **stretch your faith and I will cause you to believe in this God of Promise**. No more will you look at the promise and say, ‘Why hasn’t the promise come?’ But your eyes will be so clear and there will be such a **focus on Me**, for this is the God of Promise.” (Heb. 12:2, Col. 3:1)

“For this is the purpose of this class. (*I Am the God of Covenant Promise*) For it will far outreach even the place where you write it and the place where you speak it, for **it will go deep into the hearts of those who have not even known promise**; and they have not even been taught of this God of promise.” (Gal. 4:28, Eph. 3:6)

And God said, **“They will hear this word and they will know I am the God of Promise**, and they can hope in Me, believe in Me, and trust in Me and know that it is I who will perform it, and it is I who will get the GLORY, for I am the One who it is ‘the Yes and the Amen.’”

God said, **“I will take you deeper and deeper into the places of your fear, your doubt and unbelief**, where you have not believed in this God of Promise. Many have died; many generations have lost their way because they have **taken their eyes off of the God of Promise**. **They looked more at the promise I gave them, instead of the One who made the promise.”** (Heb. 3:19, Rom. 8:15, Mat. 21:21)

“So I will bring you in to a ‘focus place’ of the Door of Promise. And I will show you too, even as I promised my Son—even from the foundations of the world I promised Him—that in **the fullness of time** He came as promised! You will understand that **your promises all have a set timing to be released**.” (1 Pet.1:20, Gal. 4:4, Ps. 102:13)

“Even when they are given”, God said, **“they have a set timing to be released and I will prepare you** for the promises that are to be released in your lifetime and you will see those promises. You may not see some promises in your lifetime and you may see them way beyond your lifetime. For in glory you will understand that those **promises were not for you but for the generations to come**.” (Heb. 11:13)

“So you will get a much **bigger picture of who I am as the God of Promise, fulfilled**.”

“Every word that I speak”, the Lord says, “has the power, the strength, the ability—**everything that is needed in that word for it to be completely fulfilled as it is birthed out in My time**. No word is weak that I give and no word is void of understanding in

the right time. No word, God says, that I give will not come to pass for what I designated it for—it will be fulfilled.” (Isa. 55:11, Heb. 1:3)

“But you must come to know Me as Lord of the Promise, which means that **NOTHING will lord over the promises that I have given you**; that nothing will lord over that which I have spoken. Nothing else will lord over! You will come to know me not just as the Lord; you will come to know Me as the Lord of Promise and Lord of the promise. Not just Lord, **BUT THE LORD OF PROMISE!**”

“I will take you even higher and I will take you deeper into My love. **For it is in My love that My promises are fulfilled—My love for you and My love for others.** For I long to release My promises to My Beloved. I have so many promises yet waiting generation after generation after generation for that one which will believe the promises that I spoke—even to the ancestors that were before them.” (Titus 3:4-7, 1 John 4:7-9)


“For did I not say that I was the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. For I move in **generational promises**, and that which I promised to Abraham which I told him that would be fulfilled many years later and even that which I spoke to Jeremiah and that which would forth come even years later.” (Acts 3:13, Jer. 32)

The Lord said, “You **will begin to understand the Bridge of the Promise** to bring you into your promised land. For I will unveil and unlock many things that are deep in your heart, in your mind and in your soul, that you will know that I AM that I AM and that I Am the God of COVENANT PROMISE.” (Ex. 3:14)

“So journey with Me, My Beloved, into a new day and even into an awakening of who I am in a fresh way—**for you will know and you will be reformed, restructured, and you will have such a renewed faith and a renewed hope and a renewed vision in Me as I take you on this journey with Me into your promised land.** “

“And your promised land begins not as a land you will see from distance, at a far distant place, but a land that you cannot see with natural eyes but only with spirit eyes. **It begins in the renewing of your mind**, believing that I Am who I Am and I will do what I say I will do, and I will command those promises to you for I am the YES and the I AMEN.” (Rom. 12:2, Eph. 1:18)
